Items to be completed on the first day of class

Forms --sign a medical release, liability form, code of conduct and casting policy

Payment—the balance is due on the first day unless you have arranged a payment plan in advance

Parent job sign up—one parent job, per child enrolled and sign up to clean one week of the semester.

Volunteers—photographers and videographers and parent coordinators and concession coordinators

Dress code: Students need to dress in modest comfortable clothing in which you can move freely. Ladies, no tank tops or spaghetti straps, your shoulders must be covered. Shirts must be long enough that when you stretch your arms above your head, your stomach remains covered. Capris, jeans, and pants are acceptable. Please no skirts or shorts. Gentleman, make sure your pants cover your undergarments. If necessary, use a belt. Tennis shoes are recommended for safety reasons.

Special needs of kids: If your kids have ANY special needs, any at all, please let us know. This includes, but is not limited to, learning disabilities, physical limitations, emotional needs, challenges with memorization, difficulty concentrating or following verbal directions, peer issues, challenges with authority, sensory issues, etc.

Ticket Policy: Each student pays for 10 tickets as a part of their tuition. Tickets are \$10 per ticket for HS shows and \$5 per ticket for MS shows. When you sell your tickets you recoup your money. Parents do not pay for tickets for the show. Siblings do need tickets if they are over the age of 5.

Absences: Because of our short production season, it really is important to attend all rehearsals to make the best performance possible. However, we know that sickness happens and other events too. If you know you will miss more than two class times, please reconsider your involvement in MoezArt this semester. If you have ANY conflicts at all during rehearsals, you MUST inform your director by January 31. Absences during production week and performances are not accepted. If a student misses a dress rehearsal they will forfeit their role.

Medications: MoezArt staff members are not allowed to give out medication, including Tylenol®, Advil®, or aspirin, without a written consent from the parent or guardian. If your student carries an epi-pen due to potentially life threatening allergies, please make sure your teacher knows where the student keeps the epi-pen. Life-threatening situations will be the only exception made to this policy.

Drop off and pick-up policy: Please do not drop your student off more than 10 minutes prior to class time. We cannot ensure proper supervision for any earlier time. Also, please pick up your student promptly at the conclusion of class. Be at the church by 2:30 or 4:30 PM. Please call your teacher if something unavoidable occurs which delays your ability to pick up your child on time.
